Critical Incident Stress Management Pre-education Workshop

2-3 hours + expenses

Course content: Teaches the emergency responder (EMS, Fire, Police, Nurse, Clergy, etc.), managers and supervisors what critical incident stress is, how it affects them and how to best manage it on a personal and departmental level, post traumatic stress disorder awareness and motivation for responder overall wellness.

<u>Acute Traumatic Stress Management Workshop:</u> 6-8 hours + expenses (Up to 15 students, each additional at \$50 each)

Course content: Training for the individual emergency responders (EMT, Fire, Police, Nurse, Clergy, etc.) to better manage their own stress <u>during</u> a crisis, how to better manage their patients stress levels <u>during</u> their crisis event and death notification training. How to keep your staff functioning at their best during periods of crisis.

Terrorism Awareness for the CISM Team & Emergency Responder 8 hours + expenses

Course Content: Essential awareness levels on the backgrounds, reasons why and methodology of terrorism, weapons of mass destruction events, the mental health impact from them and how to begin to prepare for such an event. This program is aimed at all emergency responders, clergy, hospital staff, mental health professionals and community leaders.

CISM Team Installation, Operations of and Management 15-30 hours + expenses
